GOSPEL REFLECTION: Listen to him. *source: Scott McClure, Creighton University* I have often wondered, likely as have many others, what it must have been like to listen to Jesus. I wonder about his voice, his mannerisms, and his tone. I wonder what it would have felt like to be in a crowd and for his eyes to rest on me, even for a moment. What if he were speaking only to me, one-on-one? For reasons like this I envy those who had the chance to walk with him and hear him. Today's readings, at first, seem to be about speaking; more specifically, humanity's misuse of speech. We have a knack for taking extraordinary gifts and misusing them, don't we? As James tells us, *this need not be so*.

As it turns out, today's readings are not about speaking at all. At least, not about our speaking. After seeing Jesus transfigured, Peter speaks although *He hardly knew what to say, they were so terrified*. Then comes the Father's voice from the clouds: *This is my beloved Son. Listen to him.*

Unlike Peter, James and John we did not see Jesus transfigured. Unlike Jesus' contemporaries, we have not heard his voice with our own ears. Is it a taller order for us to carry out the Father's command here and now than it was for Peter, James and John who saw and heard these things? I don't know. But I'm inclined to keep trying.
