LIVE THE LITURGY: Walking with Jesus

Today is Palm Sunday, the day we hear the passion of Jesus. But this day is about much more than simply reading or hearing the passion. This is the beginning of the time when we walk with Jesus in his sorrow, his fears and his suffering. So often when we come to Jesus, it's all about us. Today, we accompany our friend and try to witness with him and support him in his last days and hours. This is the time we have compassion for Jesus. We may hesitate and feel unworthy. How can we have compassion for Jesus? We have compassion for the God who became man and suffered with us and for us. The root of the word compassion means to "suffer with." That is what Jesus has done for us by becoming human -- and that is what we do for Jesus this week. Next Saturday night at the Easter Vigil, Mary Magdalene is told by the young man at the tomb, "Go and tell the disciples and Peter." Spread the word of Jesus and his love. Remain vulnerable to those who are in pain. Be a witness for Jesus in this world. Most of all, we are invited to feel how deeply we are loved by Jesus – loved so much that he died for us.

A Stewardship Moment "If anyone would serve me," says Jesus in today's Gospel, "let him follow me; where I am, there will my servant be." In what way is Jesus inviting me to follow Him? What service is he asking of me?
