PERMANENT DEACON MINISTRY GROWING;

ALMOST 15,000 ACTIVE IN U.S. The number of permanent deacons in the United States continues to increase, according to a national survey released by the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB). The bishops began to ordain permanent deacons for the United States in the early seventies. The ministry emphasizes roles in liturgy, preaching and service. Currently there are more than 18,000 deacons, about 3,000 of them retired. There are currently 104 deacons in the Archdiocese of Dubuque.
