VATICAN CITY, August 06, 2013 - Francis is again calling the faithful to be bold in proclaiming the Gospel, countering any claim that publicly witnessing to Christ is an assault on others' freedom. Francis said: "It would be ... an error to impose something on the consciences of our brethren. But to propose to their consciences the truth of the Gospel and salvation in Jesus Christ, with complete clarity and with total respect for free options which it presents ... is a tribute to this freedom."

Francis said we must always have "the courage and the joy of proposing, with respect, an encounter with Christ."
