LENTEN REGULATIONS

Ash Wednesday & Good Friday: days of fast & abstinence.

Fridays of Lent: abstinence

Abstinence means we do not eat meat on that day. You are obliged to observe the fast days from the day after your fourteenth birthday.

Fasting means that we eat only one full meal and two other light meals. Eating between meals is not permitted. Those obliged to fast from the day after your eighteenth birthday until the day after your fifty-ninth birthday. Pregnant women and people who are sick are not obliged to fast.
