**GRANT** - St. Mary/Immaculate Conception School Board of the parishes of St. Mary of Guttenberg, Immaculate Conception of North Buena Vista and St. Joseph of Garnavillo is **the recipient of \$7495 from the Archbishop Kucera Grant Awards** from the Archdiocese of Dubuque Educational Development Fund. The grant was awarded for tuition assistance those families who can least afford the cost of attending a Catholic School. A portion of the grant was also directed towards tuition assistance for minority students who qualify for Federal School Lunch Program. Awards for these two program totaled \$500,00 for the 2015-16 program year. The Archbishop Kucera Grant Awards annually provides \$100,000 for faith formation resources and leadership development for faith formation leaders, catechists, Catholic school administrators and teachers. The grant also covers one third of the program cost for adults enrolled in the Archdiocesan IMPACT Program. The Archdiocesan Educational Development Fund was developed for the purpose of supporting the educational programs of the Archdiocese. This is the thirtieth year that grants have been awarded. Over 9.5 million dollars have been distributed since the Archdiocesan Educational Development Fund was established. Grants are made possible through the generous donations of contributors and parishioners throughout the Archdiocese.
