“Fasting” means one full meal and two lighter meals with no eating between meals. Ash Wednesday & Good Friday only. You are obliged to observe from the day after your 18th birthday until the day after your 59th birthday. Pregnant women and people who are sick are not obliged to fast.

“Abstinence” means no meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent beginning the day after your 14th birthday.
