POPE FRANCIS – SIX NEW BEATITUDES

Pope Francis has underlined how the Beatitudes are a Christian’s “identity card” that “identify us as followers of Jesus.” The Pope then went on to list six new Beatitudes “to confront the troubles and anxieties of our age with the spirit and love of Jesus.” He listed them as:

BLESSED are those who remain faithful while enduring evils inflicted on them by others, and forgive them from their heart.

BLESSED are those who look into the eyes of the abandoned and marginalized, and show them their closeness.

BLESSED are those who see God in every person, and strive to make others also discover him.

BLESSED are those who protect and care for our common home.

BLESSED are those who renounce their own comfort in order to help others.

BLESSED are those who pray and work for full communion between Christians.
